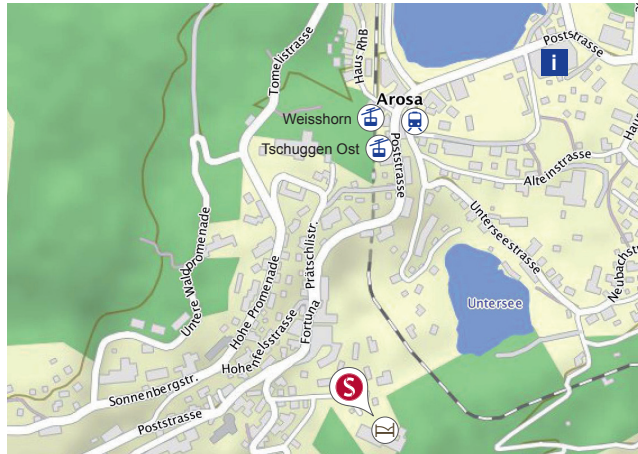

How to get here

By rail

→ Basel/Berne – Zurich – Chur – Arosa: direct connections with IR/IC/EC/TGV-trains from Basel, Zurich, St. Gallen, Hamburg, Brussels and Paris (only on Saturday in winter) to Chur. From Chur (platform 2) it takes about 1 hour to travel on the Rhaetian Railway to Arosa.

→ Lugano – Bellinzona – Chur – Arosa: from Chur (platform 2) it takes about 1 hour to travel on the Rhaetian Railway to Arosa.

We will gladly collect you from the railway station if you wish. Just let us know your time of arrival.

By car

→ from Berne/Basel – Zurich: on the motorway A1/A3-A13 as far as the exit “Chur-Nord”.

→ from Lugano – Bellinzona – San Bernardino: on the motorway A13 as far as the exit “Chur-Süd”.

From Chur follow the signs → Arosa. The legendary climb up, with its 360 bends, begins by the secondary school. It's an unforgettable experience! Once in Arosa, drive as far as the Kursaal and then turn left and go to the end of Seewaldstrasse.
